

Assisted Membership Scheme

Following the 2016 Harmeny AC AGM, the club has introduced a new 'Assisted Membership' scheme. Applications are welcome at the beginning of the membership year and funds are allocated accordingly. Applications out with this period will depend on availability.

As the scheme is limited, any applications received after the 14th October will only be considered if places are still available. In the event that the scheme is oversubscribed, the board has discretion to allocate membership.

Assisted membership is available to those in receipt of:

- Income Support, Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA), Income-based Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Income related Universal Credit While your monthly household income before tax is less than £1,250 a month
- Working Tax credits (with disability or child tax) or Child Tax Credit While earning less than £17,474 a year
- The club will consider applications for concessionary membership from people with low or modest means who do not meet the above but can satisfactorily demonstrate that they are unable to pay the full membership fee.

The financial assistance provided is for every session so please make every effort to attend. Assistance will be reviewed for any athlete not attending 80% of sessions. You must apply every year to ensure continuing eligibility.
