

Gifted and Assisted Scheme

Currently our assisted membership scheme reduces the cost of our weekly training fees and charges no annual subscription. The Board of Trustees are pleased to announce an extension to this with our Gifted and Assisted scheme. This has the following additional benefits:

- No charge for training sessions
- £200 annual payment to be spent on entry fees, travel, kit, physio. Expenses must be pre-agreed with your coach before payment is made.

To qualify for the scheme you must be:

- Part of our Assisted Membership Scheme already (acceptance into the scheme is administered independently by Darren Caveroli)
- A first claim member of Harmeny AC.
- U17 or above age group
- Ranked in the Top 5 in your event in Scotland at the end of the outdoor season in September
- All awards are at the final discretion of the Board of Trustees

Athletes are expected to apply for funding from available sources such as The Ron Pickering Fund, The Lloyd Cowan Bursary, Edinburgh Talented Athlete Support Scheme etc.

You must apply each year in October and can remain on the assisted membership scheme until you finish full time education.
